Fond du Lac, Wisconsin statistics reveal a great community to raise a family. Good schools, the natural beauty of the land, low crime and low unemployment rates all point to a comfortable suburban life.

But the Fond du Lac County statistics on religion tell a different story. This is an area where only 27% of the population identify as protestant. One pastor wrote about suburbia, "Behind the barriers of immaculate lawns and white picket fences hide real people. People full of fear, anxiety, stress, idolatry, sin, and

almost endless potential for gospel advance if we would engage them well." Another pastor says, "The message of the suburbs, in a nutshell, is self-empowerment. Self-enhancement. Self-fulfillment. Self is at the center, and all things serve the self. The primary values of suburbia are convenience, abundance, and comfort. In suburbia you can have it all."

Fond du Lac needs a vision of life that is larger than their day-to-day existence. A PCA church plant in this city with little to no reformed

presence has a great opportunity to see Kingdom growth.

The majority of churches in the Wisconsin Presbytery are invested in their church planting network, "On Wisconsin." The goal of "On Wisconsin" is to plant 16 more churches in Wisconsin in 10 years.

Since 2012, 5 churches have taken root, 5 new works have started and 2 RUF chapters have begun.

By the grace of God, a church in Fond du Lac will soon be added to those numbers.




Population by Age
